

Serving of alcoholic beverages at the Swedish Exhibition & Congress Centre/Gothia Towers

The premises of the Swedish Exhibition & Congress Centre/Gothia Towers are supervised pursuant to the Swedish Alcohol Act (1 January 2011). This means that all service of alcoholic beverages may only be managed by the Swedish Exhibition & Congress Centre/Gothia Towers, which are responsible for alcohol licensing in all rooms and areas in the premises. It is our responsibility to ensure that this is complied with.

- According to the licensing authority of Gothenburg city all alcoholic beverage serving must be managed by the holder of the alcohol license
- Alcoholic beverages are spirits, wine, beer and other fermented beverages over 2,25% alcohol
- For serving your own alcoholic beverage in your stand, the products must be purchased by the Swedish Exhibition & Congress Centre/Gothia Towers as the alcohol license holder. It is prohibited to bring your own alcoholic beverages into our premises or handle them there

What rules apply to me as an exhibitor?

If you want to serve beer, wine or spirits at your stand or anywhere else, you must order it from our Stand Catering service. It is convenient and easy. We will deliver it straight to your stand or another area and will provide beverages, glasses, staff etc. And if it all gets used up, we can quickly deliver more. Alcoholic beverages may be served from 11:00 AM onwards.

**At certain fairs, the organizer may decide on a later start time for alcohol serving*

The Environmental Administration (Miljöförvaltningen) applies the following requirements for the handling of food in the premises:

Proper hygiene procedures must be followed when handling food, for instance regarding cleaning facilities and storage temperatures. These requirements apply to all stages of handling including storage, preparation, packaging and serving. Check with the Environmental Administration to find out which rules apply to your specific product.

Supervision

Supervision of restaurants and premises is carried out by a municipal restaurant inspector, staff from the County Administrative Board and the police, for the purpose of enforcing the Alcohol Act.
